

REMINDER FROM THE FORT CARSON CLAIMS OFFICE

SHIPMENT OF OCIE/TA-50:

1. If you have had OCIE/TA-50 items missing from a household goods shipment, you may file a claim directly with the carrier within 9 months if the items were shipped under FRV (Full Replacement Value) program. If your shipment was not under the FRV program, you may file directly with the local military claims office. Since OCIE/TA-50 are government property you will have to reimburse the government (CIF or your unit) within 30 days of payment.
2. Just like any other personal property damaged or lost during a government-sponsored shipment, you must submit a DD Form 1840R within 75 days after delivery directly to the carrier or to the military claims office. Be sure to retain proof of any transmittal directly to the carrier.
3. If you miss the 9 month deadline, you may file your claim with the nearest military claims office within 2 years of delivery.
