### About the Program

Colorado Technical University's Wounded Warrior Scholarship program began in 2008, in partnership with the Yellow Ribbon Fund Inc., to provide an opportunity through education to a population with uncertain futures — those whose lives are forever altered by a debilitating physical injury while serving their country. Each year, 25 wounded service members and 25 spouses of wounded service members receive a full scholarship to attend Colorado Technical University.

With nearly 40,000 military members injured in conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan, we're proud to help positively impact the lives of these extraordinary men and women and their spouses through higher education. To date, Colorado Technical University has provided 200 scholarships worth nearly \$3 million. The Wounded Warrior Scholarship program is just one part of the overall commitment Colorado Technical University has made to serve active military, veterans and their families.

### Who is Eligible?

- Active Duty wounded in Operation Iraqi Freedom/Operation Enduring Freedom, currently recovering in Warrior Transition Units
- Spouses of Active Duty wounded in Operation Iraqi Freedom/Operation Enduring Freedom
- Veterans wounded in Operation Iraqi Freedom/Operation Enduring Freedom
- Spouses of Veterans wounded in Operation Iraqi Freedom/Operation Enduring Freedom
