

MILITARY SPOUSES



Army Community Service Employment Readiness offers programs to help military spouses apply for competitive federal employment if you were married prior to arriving at your current duty station (Fort Carson).

1. Executive Order (E.O.) 13473 otherwise known as spouse preference, gives you two years (2 years from date of the PCS Order, not the date arrived station) to use this authority for applying for federal or government jobs.
2. For Military Spouses returning from overseas, you have a different consideration. You may be affected by Executive Order 12721. If applicable, you will have three (3) years to use this order as your authority.
3. For Military Spouses whose sponsor has been awarded a 100% Service-Connected Disability, you have a different authority. Your geographical location is not limited.
