ADVISORY: DMV HOLIDAY CLOSURES

ADVISORY: GATE 3 CCTV INSTALLATION

The Directorate of Emergency Services will be upgrading the Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) System at Gate 3 starting Oct. 11. The upgrades are expected to take approximately one week to complete. Temporary lane closures will be required while new hardware is being installed. The community is advised to expect some delays at this gate during the process.

ADVISORY: GATE 4 AVB REPAIR

The Directorate of Emergency Services will be conducting repairs on the Gate 4 barrier system Oct. 15 from 8 a.m. to about 2 p.m. The outbound lanes on McGrath Avenue just inside the gate will be reduced to one lane during the repair process. There will also be intermittent closures of the outbound lanes after the repairs have been made to test the system.
