SUBJ: REQUIREMENTS FOR HAZMAT CERTIFICATION PUBLICATIONS

THE FOLLOWING PUBLICATIONS ARE MINIMUM MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR PERSONNEL ASSIGNED AS A CERTIFIER OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS FOR TRANSPORTATION:

- 1. Department of Defense, Defense Transportation Regulations (DOD 4500.9-R, Part II, Chapter 204)**
 - 2. Air Force InterService Manual (AFMAN 24-204-I)**
 - 3. Department of Transportation, Title 49, Code of Regulations (Parts 100 – 185), Transportation of Hazardous Materials**
 - 4. International Air Transportation Association (IATA) Dangerous Goods Regulations**
- OR**
- 5. Air International Regulations Shipper's Guide – AIR (LabelMaster)**
 - 6. International Maritime Dangerous Goods Regulations (IMDG)**
 - 6. DOT Emergency Response Guide (ERG)**
