

Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT)

To take the AFCT you must:

- Pick up a Form 4187 in Room 150 or in the Testing Center, Room 217; mention that you are currently in the GT Prep course.
- Get your Form 4187 signed by your commander.
- Return your signed Form 4187 to the Testing Center preferably one week before your requested test date, but no later than one day before your test.
- Bring your military ID the day of your test.

Other information about the AFCT:

- You may only take the AFCT three times in your entire military career. The ASVAB you took at the MEPS station does not count toward your three times.
- You must wait six months between test dates.
- The General Technical (GT) portion of the test is what you will study in the GT prep course, which is comprised of the following subtests:
 - Arithmetic Reasoning (AR).....16 questions, 39 minutes
 - Word Knowledge (WK)..... 16 questions, 8 minutes
 - Paragraph Comprehension (PC).....11 questions, 22 minutes
- There are also six other subtests which compromise the AFCT. The subtests are not covered in the GT Prep course; however, you are encouraged to study them on your own time. These six subtests are as follows:
 - General Science (GS).....16 questions, 8 minutes
 - Mathematics Knowledge (MK).....16 questions, 20 minutes
 - Electronics Information (EI)..... 16 questions, 8 minutes
 - Auto and Shop Information (AS)..... 11 questions, 7 minutes/11 questions, 6 minutes
 - Mechanical Comprehension (MC).....16 questions, 20 minutes
 - Assembling Objects (AO).....16 questions, 16 minutes
