

**The National Environmental Policy Act process steps and proposed general timelines are shown here up to the release of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement.**

**The Army proposes to expand the Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site (PCMS) in southeastern Colorado.**

**If a federal agency anticipates that an undertaking may significantly impact the environment, or if a project is environmentally controversial, a federal agency may choose to prepare an EIS without having to first prepare an Environmental Assessment. An EIS has been determined to be the appropriate level of NEPA analysis for the proposed expansion of PCMS.**

**A Notice of Intent (NOI) will be submitted to the Federal Register on a date yet to be determined (Late 2007 or early 2008).**

**The affected public, agencies, and all interested parties will be invited to public scoping meetings and have the opportunity to submit all input after the NOI has been published (Early 2008).**

**The Draft EIS (DEIS) will be available for review and comment after information and data have been collected, analyzed, and documented (Potentially mid 2008). Public meetings will also be held and public comment gathered at the time of the release of the DEIS.
