

Deployment and Reconstitution Tracking Software (DARTS)



The DARTS application provides a standardized suite of software for AC units and mobilizing RC units to conduct Readiness and Deployment Checklist (DA Form 7425) and Deployment Cycle Support (DCS) functionality. The DARTS application validates each of the “functional areas” in the Soldier Readiness Process (SRP).

DARTS is the only approved automated system to support Soldier Readiness Processing (SRP).



DARTS

Read access only to Personnel, Medical, ACS, Chaplain Modules

DARTS is the only authorized method to process Soldiers for deployment and redeployment

Write access can be granted to units for security, training, supply and logistics modules

Submit AKO username to SRP Site Manager and the DARTS Manager

✓ MEDPROS

Provides the Overall Unit Status Report Medical Only

Can get granted read & write access depending on your job and credentials

Provides many tools that units can use PRIOR to SRP, for example, vision

It is a powerful tool allowing the chain of command to determine the medical and dental readiness of individuals, units, and task forces

HQDA mandates the use of DARTS

From the Army Mobilization Operations Planning and Execution System (AMOPES).

- *All individuals deploying OCONUS, to a theater of operations, will complete SRP requirements. This process will be validated in DARTS.*
- *AC units will complete and document SRP processing in DARTS. For non-unit related RC Soldiers, SRP will be done at home station and verified as the Soldiers are processed through a CONUS Replacement Center (CRC) and documented in DARTS.*
- *DARTS is the only approved automated system to support Soldiers Readiness Processing (SRP).*

- DARTS provides an automated capability to determine individual GO/NO-GO readiness and deployment status and overall unit deployability status.
 - DARTS is an unclassified application found on the FORSCOM NIPR website, <https://guardian.forscom.army.mil> ,click on Darts (or go straight to <https://darts.forscom.army.mil/Darts>).
 - The information within DARTS is FOUO.
 - DARTS can only be accessed from a [.mil](#) domain
 - Users must have a valid AKO account that has been registered in DARTS by the system administrator from the respective installation or command for access. Access and permissions are granted based on the user's job responsibility and need to know.
 - DARTS accounts inactive for 60 days are locked; accounts inactive for more than 90 days are automatically deleted.



DARTS receives personnel readiness and unit data from various Army information systems including:

- Reserve Component Automation System (RCAS)
- Mobilization Planning Data Viewer (MPDV)
- Medical Protection System (MEDPROS)
- EMILPO
- Global Command and Control System – Army (GCCS-A)
- Department of the Army Mobilization Processing System (DAMPS)

AC unit and personnel data is transmitted from EMILPO to DARTS based on a request from the installation specifying the UIC(s).



Benefits of DARTS

- Standardization of Readiness Process
- Immediate identification of SRP deficiencies
- Immediate snapshot of unit and Soldier readiness
- Don't have to re-do complete SRP if checklist is lost or destroyed (can just re-print)

Redeployment – RPDRC

- The RPDRC checklist allows you to track completion of redeployment tasks.
- Like the SRP Checklist, some of the checks can be accomplished without individual participation by checking automated systems and by reviewing records, files and report.
- Unlike the SRP Checklist, the Redeployment Checklist doesn't list a certifying official for each item. Instead only the date of the last check is shown.
