**Medical Education and Demonstration of Individual Competence (MEDIC)
Training Program Information Paper**

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MEDIC Course Description:

MEDIC Table Training is a 7 day course with an emphasis on Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TC3) as well as EMT-Basic Refresher training. All 68W Soldiers are required to complete Training Tables I-VII and Table VIII Validation annually as outlined in TC 8-800. Completing Tables I-VII provides the 68W with 48 hours of CEU's toward their NREMT re-registration. Completion Table VIII Validation meets the verification of skill competence. Soldiers are generally not excused from any of the MEDIC training. Previously scheduled medical, dental, or legal appointments may be excused on a case by case basis and will be determined by the MSTC NCOIC and staff.

Completion of MEDIC Table Training is required annually to meet NREMT re-registration requirements.

MEDIC Train the Trainer: Throughout the MEDIC training, MSTC staff will evaluate Soldiers for instructor potential and recommend them to attend the "Train the Trainer" offered the day after completing MEDIC training. The criteria evaluated will include EMT and TC3 written exams (>85%), performance of skills and validation, and leadership ability. Soldiers completing the training will receive a Certificate of Training.

Prerequisites:

- Registration forms should be submitted no later than 30 days prior to class start date.
- Soldiers must have a MOS of 68W.
- Soldiers must have a current NREMT-B certification or higher.
- Soldiers must have the ability to lift up to 125 pounds.

Scheduling a MEDIC Course:

Units who wish to schedule their personnel for a MEDIC Course may contact the MSTC at 719-526-2820 or email carson.mstc1@us.army.mil All Soldiers will be required to bring their IBA, ACH/Kevlar and water source on the last 2 days for outdoor training.

Class VIII Expendable Supplies:

Unit commanders **may** be required to resource the Class VIII expendable supplies to the MSTC in one of two ways.

1. Provide the following supplies to the MSTC five (5) duty days prior to the start date of training. Class VIII supplies will need to be ordered at least 4 weeks prior training to ensure all supplies are available.
2. MIPR the funds for training NLT four (4) weeks prior to the start date of training to the MSTC account. Contact the MSTC for details concerning MIPR of funds if necessary.

*See the list of supplies below; most items are per soldier and will require units to order accordingly.
