



Mountain Post Medical Simulation Training Center (MSTC) Fort Carson, Colorado FY 2013 Training Schedule

The Medical Education and Demonstration of Individual Competence (MEDIC) course will be offered to Soldiers with upcoming EMT-Basic expiration. If completed annually, it will meet the 68W's requirement for EMT-Basic Re-registration. 48CEU or 72CEU classes are available. Class size is limited to 36 Soldiers

The International Trauma Life Support (ITLS) Course is offered to the 68W and Soldiers with EMT Certification. The length is 3 days for adult and 1 day for pediatric. Class size is limited to 30 Soldiers

Basic Life Support (BLS) training is a requirement for all 68W Soldiers every two years. All BLS courses are recertification courses and are completed in 4 hours. Class size is limited to 15 Soldiers

Basic Life Support Instructor (BLS-I) training is available for unit medics. Class size is limited to 6 Soldiers.

Combat Lifesaver Training is available for units without medics. Units without their own medics should request CLS courses to be MSTC Instructor Led. Units with medics may request to use the MSTC STX Lane to conduct their CLS training with their own medics on day 4 of the course. Class size is limited to 36 Soldiers

Improved First Aid Kit (IFAK) Familiarization Training can be available for units as requested. Course length is typically 4-6 hours and can accommodate up to 36 Soldiers

Weekend training for National Guard and Reserve units can be made available at the MSTC with prior coordination. Units will typically provide an appropriate number of qualified 68W medics to facilitate the training.

Duty uniform is required for all students and instructors.
