

## **Spousal Identification Renewal**

1. Dependent ID card and valid driver's license, or valid permanent resident card.  
Sponsor must be present unless a valid Power of Attorney is presented, or the sponsor has pre-signed DD 172-2 and has been scanned into DEERS within the past 90 days.  
\*\*Reminder: Both forms of identification provided will have to be matching in name. If the spouse got married and has not yet changed their maiden name with Social Security Office, the spouse ID will be printed under the maiden name.\*\*
2. If dependent ID has been lost or confiscated, two forms of valid ID
  - o **Primary form must be a photo ID:** valid (*not expired*) driver's license or valid (*not expired*) passport
  - o **Secondary form of ID could be:** Social Security card or birth certificate if name is matching the primary form of ID.

## **Dependent Child ID**

1. Birth certificate and Social Security card if under 18.
2. Children 18 years and older are considered adults; they are required to provide two valid forms of ID.  
**Primary form must be a photo ID:** driver's license, state ID, passport or if the child already has a dependent ID that is not expired it could be used as a primary form of ID.  
**A secondary form of ID could be:** Social Security card, birth certificate, state ID or passport.
3. Note: Children under 10 years of age do not receive an ID card unless the following condition(s) exist:
  - o Single parent family
  - o Joint military family
  - o Child residing outside of household
  - o Severe medical condition

## **Dependents/Full Time Students, Children Ages 21-23**

Note: Sponsor **must** update dependent's DEERS information unless valid Power of Attorney is presented. Sponsor **must** provide over 50% of dependent's care.

School certification with the following information:

- o Student letter: Form must be on official letter head from an accredited school.
- o Date start of school.
- o Expected date of graduation.
- o Must state full time or at least 12 credit hours.
- o Point of contact, name, phone number and signature of school official.

**Primary form of ID must be a photo ID:** Old ID (not expired) or valid state or federal ID (not expired).

**Secondary form of ID can be:** Social Security card, birth certificate or passport.
