UPDATE: Army Special Ops Aviation Command noise-generating exercise delayed

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Training has been delayed for the Special Operations Aviation Training Battalion, U.S. Army Special Operations Aviation Command, unit which was supposed to begin exercises today throughout the Front Range, northern and southern Colorado regions.

The unit's new training exercise dates are scheduled from May 11 to May 20.

The training is necessary to qualify rated student pilots and non-rated crew members in multi-mode radar, mountain and desert environments, so the unit is prepared for any potential mission they may be called upon to support around the globe.
