FORT CARSON, Colo. – The 4th Infantry Division and Fort Carson will conduct a virtual change of responsibility and farewell retreat ceremony Monday at 4:55 p.m. at Manhart Field on post.

During the ceremony, Command Sgt. Maj. T.J. Holland will relinquish responsibility of the Division and Fort Carson to Command Sgt. Maj. Adam S. Nash.
