Media Opportunity **2SBCT, 4ID hosts EFMB graduation for elite medical Soldiers**

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Select Fort Carson Soldiers will receive the Expert Field Medical Badge (EFMB) during a graduation ceremony at Founders Field on post at 9 a.m. Friday.

The ceremony, hosted by the 2nd Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division, will follow the completion of a 12-mile foot march which is the last event participants must complete in order to receive the EFMB.

Soldiers who are competing for the honor include officers, warrant officers and enlisted personnel who have demonstrated exceptional competence and outstanding performance in field medical tasks and skills throughout the rigorous testing process. All competitors have either a primary military occupational series in the medical field or are pilots who have a special medical-skill identifier and are assigned to an air ambulance unit.
