## Media Advisory **Fort Carson Fire and Emergency Services fights fire on post**

**FORT CARSON, Colo.** – Fort Carson Fire and Emergency Personnel are currently responding to a range fire, dubbed the Wild Horse Fire, on postoff of Highway 115, south of Gate 6 and north of Turkey Creek.

Reports indicate that roughly 200 acres have burned, and that the fire started on the west side of the highway; however, due to high winds it jumped across the highway and is now burning on post in a training area.

Mutual aid partners including the following departments are on scene: Highway 115, Security, Colorado Springs, Cimarron Hills, CSU Utilities, U.S. Forest Service, Tri Lakes, Wescott, and El Paso County Wildland. No structures or personnel are currently threatened.
