## Media Advisory **Fort Carson Fire and Emergency Services continue fire fight**

**FORT CARSON, Colo.** – The Wild Horse Fire, located on post off of Highway 115, south of Gate 6 and north of Turkey Creek is now 10% contained.

Crews are tying in the southern perimeter to ensure there are no further hotspots which pose a threat. Bambi bucket operations along Highway 115 are complete for the day, but aerial assets will continue to fight the fire in other areas until sundown. The highway has reopened. The affected area still stands at the same acreage, 580 acres.

There will be active fire and smoke on the interior of the fire throughout the night and into the next few days. Aerial assets will return tomorrow with Bambi bucket operations for any hotspots.

Crews will continue to work and monitor the perimeter throughout the night. Fire line operations will start again tomorrow with Fort Carson crews and mutual aid assets.

Another update will be provide at approximately 8 a.m.
