## Media Advisory **Fort Carson Fire and Emergency Services continues to fight Wild Horse fire**

**FORT CARSON, Colo.** –The Wild Horse Fire, located on and off post along the Highway 115 corridor, south of Fort Carson's Gate 6 and north of Turkey Creek has now burned approximately 670 acres and remains 10% contained.

Fort Carson crews have established a solid perimeter and are now focusing on interior hot spots.

Bambi bucket operations along Highway 115 will continue throughout the day, but the highway is expected to remain open throughout the day. Active fire and smoke from the interior of the fire will be visible from Hwy. 115 for the next several days.

At this time, all assets on scene are organic to Fort Carson except one forestry crew from the U.S. Forest Service, Pikes Peak District.

We continue to assess there is no danger to people or infrastructure on Fort Carson.

Another update will be provide at approximately 5 p.m.
