Wild Horse Fire now 40% contained

FORT CARSON, Colo. – The Wild Horse Fire, which is located along the Highway 115 corridor, south of Fort Carson's Gate 6 and north of Turkey Creek is now approximately 40% contained.

Fort Carson crews will remain on ground to fight any hot spots that may arise. Smoke may still be visible from Highway 115 for the next several days.

The 4th Combat Aviation Brigade, 4th Infantry Division, UH-60 Black Hawks have completed air support operations but will remain on standby to support as necessary.

All firefighting assets external to Fort Carson have been released. Ongoing assessments have shown there is no danger to people or infrastructure on the installation.

No further updates will be provided unless the situation changes.
