Fort Carson hosts Fall Festival, Zombie Dash

FORT CARSON, Colo. – Fall Fest, hosted by the Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation, will be held at Iron Horse Park Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The festival is free for all DOD ID card holders but is not open to the general public.

The event will be limited to 250 personnel at a time, which is in compliance with CDC and Army Public Health guidelines. In order to allow maximum participation for all, seven one-hour time blocks will be offered.

The Zombie Dash 5K coincides with the fall celebration and will be held at Ivy Physical Fitness Center from 9-11:30 a.m. Waves of 50 runners will be released in 30 minute increments to support social distancing standards.

This event is designed to celebrate fall and bring the community together. Activities include trick-or-treating, giveaways, a pumpkin patch, a scavenger hunt and more. Food and beverages will also be available for purchase.

All Service Members, DoD Civilians, contractor employees, dependents, and all other individuals on the installation will wear approved face coverings when they cannot maintain six feet of social distance in public.
