Units conduct noise-generating training

FORT CARSON, Colo. — Noise-generating training, including artillery and aviation operations, began Tuesday and will be conducted by three units on Fort Carson training ranges and along the Front Range until Nov. 20.

Units involved in the training include the 1st Stryker Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division, the 3rd Armored Brigade Combat Team, 4th Inf. Div., and the Special Operations Aviation Training Battalion, U.S. Army Special Operations Aviation Command.

The training is necessary so units are prepared for any potential mission they may be called upon to support around the globe.

Increased noise and dust should be expected including in the evenings and throughout the night due to large-caliber training with live munitions on Fort Carson. Increased noise and dust should also be expected along the Front Range due to increased aviation operations.

Fort Carson is dedicated to being good neighbors and will continue to inform the public about training events that may affect surrounding communities. We will continue to listen to our community and work through any noise issues that may arise. We strive to balance our training requirements with respecting our neighboring communities.
